Founded in 1893, Town & Country is the fifth oldest women's club in the United States.

Town & Country Club is the pre-eminent private women's club in San Francisco. Since 1893, the Club has provided a warm and gracious setting for women of all ages who value social connection, fine dining, and intellectual engagement. Members of Town & Country Club enjoy camaraderie, lifelong learning, and a welcoming atmosphere at its impeccable clubhouse located in the heart of San Francisco.

The clubhouse was originally located in a loft at 23 Post Street until the Great San Francisco Earthquake of 1906 reduced the building to a heap of rubble and ashes. In 1909, Town & Country Club moved into its permanent home—a newly erected classic Georgian red brick building at the corner of Maiden Lane and Stockton Street.

At the center of the Union Square shopping and theater district, Town & Country Club is close to shops, museums, restaurants, and the financial district. Nearby, the Union Square subway stop, cable car, and bus lines provide easy access to the Club and many visitor attractions. Members treasure the Club's extensive library, exquisite menu, multi-faceted programming, and superb service.

LIBRARY

Affectionately referred to as the jewel of Town & Country Club, the circulating library holds more than 8,000 cataloged items, including contemporary fiction, nonfiction, mysteries, and memoirs. The library also offers an extensive collection of the classics, as well as newspapers, magazines, e-books, and audiobooks. Of special interest is the library's California collection, which is distinctive for its breadth and historical treasures.

In close collaboration with the Library Committee, the Club's full-time librarian carefully curates the collection, arranges author visits, manages the monthly Book Group program, and provides advisory services to members looking for their next great read.
